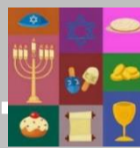

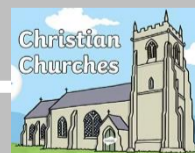

- Religious people from different faith who are special- vicar, priest, etc



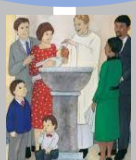
Special Places
