The UK

Dear Parents and Carers.

Welcome to Year 1! I hope you have all had a relaxing summer break and are ready to start back at school.

Our topic this half term is all about 'The UK.' We will be learning about where we live and the countries that make up the United Kingdom.

English

This term we will begin by reading the book 'The Queen's Hat' by Steve Antony. We will be writing our own diary entries for a character of our choice and figuring out who stole the queen's hat!

We will then be looking at the story 'The queen's handbag' which is another book by Steve Antony.

Within Year 1, we will be using

Maths

the White Rose scheme to support the teaching and learning of maths. This term we will be recapping on our numbers 0-10 and carrying out addition and subtraction calculations using part-whole models. The children will be working out of their very own workbook and using hands on physical equipment as much as possible to develop their understanding of number.

Science

In our science lessons, we will be learning about materials. We will be exploring the properties of everyday materials and looking at understanding why certain materials have certain functions. We will link our science lessons to our DT topic, thinking about suitable materials to make play equipment for a park.

Geography -The UK

In geography, the children will be learning where the UK is on a world map. We will be exploring which countries make up the British Isles and looking at locating and identifying the charactristics of each country.

Design & Technology


This term the children will be exploring how to make structures! We will be looking at different types of structures that already exist and exploring how to make our own so they do not collapse!

Computing

In computing this term, the children will be learning about being safe online. Using Purple Mash, the children will learn how to log on, log off and navigate the desktop. They will learn how to save their work and then open it again from the correct folder.

Phonics

Continuing with the use of First-Class Phonics, children will continue to develop their phonic knowledge and bring reading books home that match the current learning.
